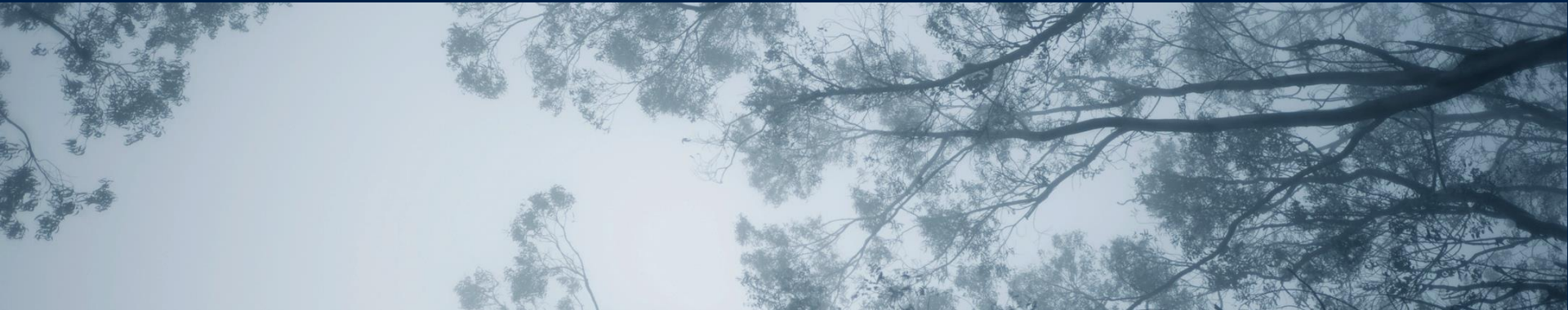




Session 5:

Improving practice - Opportunities for better coordinated DRR and CCA efforts



Objectives

- The objective of this session is to explore how DRR and CCA could be better coordinated at a practical level.
- Yesterday we looked at what is happening now we are considering what could or should happen!



Format

- Three stations dealing with different aspects of CCA and DRR integration
- Each group rotates so ideas build and develop
 - First group brainstorms ideas
 - Second group adds more ideas, begins to structure
 - Third group adds further ideas, structure, prioritises and ‘reality checks’ (what might be possible?)
- As the groups rotate you all get the change to be first, second and third
- Please keep the same colour throughout (take your pens with you!)
- Be creative - there are no rules - draw, write, map, whatever works for you!

Stations

- *Station 1: Improving knowledge sharing and integration (**this room, led by Rob**)*
 - How can knowledge be better integrated and shared across and between CCA and DDR? **(BLUE TO START)**
- *Station 2: Improving horizontal and vertical coordination (**creative space, led by Jaro**)*
 - How to bridge gap between CCA and DRR communities both vertically (between decision-making levels and spatial scales) and horizontally **(RED TO START)**
- *Station 3: Integrating CCA and DRR into Practice (**creative space, led by Reimund**)*
 - What is needed to help those working at sub-national level to integrate CCA and DRR into local decision-making? **(GREEN TO START)**
